

Pre-Requisites for Internship
Students Preparing for 2014-15 Internship Year

*Students going on internship are expected to have completed at least **two-thirds** of their M.Div. courses, including the courses listed below. Students lacking one of the courses listed below may petition to defer **one** course until their return from internship, after consultation with their academic advisor:*

I. Division of Biblical Studies

Biblical Greek

Jesus and the Gospels **or** Life and Letters of Paul (pre-req: Biblical Greek)

Pentateuch

Recommended: Biblical Hebrew

Prophets course (e.g., Israel's Prophets; pre-req: Biblical Hebrew)

Note: We recommend taking Biblical Hebrew & Prophets during the same year in order to keep your language learning fresh and usable in Prophets.

II. Division of Historical and Systematic Theology

Lutheran Confessional Heritage (pre-req: Church History I)

Church History I

Systematic Theology I (pre-req: Church History I)

Systematic Theology II (pre-req: Church History I)

Recommended: The second requirement in Church History: Church History II or American/Lutheran Church History

III. Division of Ministry

Worship

Preaching (pre-req: Gospels or Paul and Worship)

Recommended: Pastoral Care Option

Recommended: Educational Ministry Option

IV. Other Pre-Internship Requirements
