

Instructions for Application

Th.M. and Ph.D. Advanced Studies Programs

General Instructions

Application deadline for all students is January 15 for the following academic year. All application items below must be received by LSTC by that date in order to be considered, including GRE, TOEFL, and IELTS test scores. A completed application includes the following items. Items may be submitted electronically to admissions@lstc.edu or via postal service to LSTC's Admissions Office, 5416 S. Comell Ave, 4th Fl. Chicago, IL 60615.

- Application for Admission. Save this document to your hard drive and open/complete in Acrobat Reader, not your browser. Mac users should use Adobe Acrobat, not Preview software. Free Adobe Reader software available here: http://www.adobe.com/products/reader.html.
- Essay no longer than two pages single-spaced describing:
 - 1. Your intellectual interests and vocational goals

 How does your proposed program of study contribute to your long-range professional and vocational goals?
 - 2. How your scholarly interests match the academic programs and the faculty strengths at LSTC Why are you applying for an advanced degree at LSTC?
- **References** from two or three people, depending on degree program. Download reference forms from www.lstc.edu, complete top portion, and have referent submit completed forms directly to LSTC.
- Writing Sample of no more than twenty pages that is representative of your work in the field in which you are applying. This may be a term paper, published essay, or portion of a larger work. If you choose to excerpt a portion from a larger work, include a one-paragraph abstract of the entire paper as an introduction to the writing sample.
- Official Transcripts sent directly from all post-secondary institutions where you have completed academic
 work. If you are currently enrolled in the final year of a Masters program, please request a transcript that
 lists all courses to date and send a final transcript upon completion of your degree. Transcripts written in
 a language other than English, German, French, Spanish, Portuguese, or Arabic must be accompanied by a
 notarized translation.
- GRE for US and Canadian students. Contact Educational Testing Services at www.ets.org/gre for test dates and locations. Only scores submitted directly by ETS to LSTC (institutional code 1026-4) will be accepted.
- TOEFL or IELTS for international students whose primary language is not English. The TOEFL or IELTS will be waived if applicants can demonstrate that they have already earned a graduate degree in which the language of instruction was English. For information about test dates and locations, contact Educational Testing Services at www.ets.org/toe3fl or www.ielts.org. Only scores taken less than two years previously and submitted directly by ETS to LSTC (institutional code 1026-4) will be accepted.
- Resume or CV (optional). While not required, including a resume or CV may strengthen your application if it
 sufficiently presents your qualifications for advanced graduate work, including education, employment, and
 publications in your field of interest.
- Additional Considerations (optional) written as a summary statement that provides any additional
 information that you think would be helpful as we consider your application, including: reflection on your
 life's journey, description of personal qualities and experiences that would commend you for advanced
 studies at LSTC.

Financial Aid

Financial aid is based primarily on merit. A limited number of advanced study scholarships and fellowships may be available for PhD students. Due to budgetary constraints, financial assistance is not generally available for ThM students.

Global Mission Scholarships are available to Lutheran international students seeking financial support. Completed scholarship applications are due by October 15 for the following academic year.

Application Fee

All advanced studies applicants must pay a one-time application fee of \$50. Fee may be paid through checks paid by bank draft, postal money order, or personal check written on a U.S. bank (payable to LSTC.)
